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### **Independent Auditors Report**

We have audited the balance sheet of *Asociación Dominicana Pro-Bienestar de la Familia, Inc.* (*PROFAMILIA*), as of December 31, 2014 and 2013, the statement of incomes, expenses and changes in the funds balances, functional expenses and cash flows for the year then ended, and a summary of material accounting policies and explanatory notes.

# Responsibility of the Management on the Financial Statements

The management is responsible for the preparation and reasonable presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the accounting practices established by the International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF). This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining the relevant internal control for the preparation and reasonable presentation and that the financial statements are free of false or erroneous disclosures, already be for fraud or error; and also to select and apply the proper accounting policies reasonable in the circumstances.

#### Responsibility of the auditors
